Indulge in a tequila tasting, where you'll explore the aging process and savour different varieties this famous spirit. Your adventure continues at Bee Friendly, a conservation sanctuary dedicated to the protection of native bees and their crucial role in Mayan culture and the ecosystem. On this guided visit, explore the world of stingless Meliponini bees, revered by the ancient Maya for their medicinal honey. Learn about their behaviour, the sustainable beekeeping efforts that help protect them, and enjoy a tasting of rare honey varieties. With views of beaches to enjoy as you round the island's southern tip, take a quick photo stop at San Martín Beach. You'll then head for your final destination, the natural limestone bridge of El Mirador, a natural rock formation shaped by the waves, offering a perfect opportunity to snap unforgettable photos, purchase a drink, or a quick bite. Finally enjoy a ride back to your ship with many new stories to tell about this amazing Mexican Destination.

XCARET ECO PARK - COZ16

Experience Xcaret - the most exciting and largest Eco Park in Latin America! This eco-archaeological park offers many activities in a tropical jungle setting on the Caribbean Sea. As you get off the ferry in Playa Del Carmen, your guide will take you to your transportation for a short ride to Xcaret. At the park, your guide will assist you on where to go, what there is to do, answer your questions and point you in the right direction. Then, you are on your own to explore and experience the park. Choose from the museum, a bird sanctuary, stables, botanical gardens, aquarium, restored Mayan ruins, a replicated Mayan village, beaches and natural pools. Even take a swim in an underground river with life vest included.

Please note: Xcaret Park is located on mainland while the ship is in Cozumel. Transfer by ferry to Playa del Carmen lasts approximately 45 minutes and could possibly be rough depending on the sea conditions. Once in mainland it is an approximately 45 mins bus drive each way to/from Xcaret, for a total travel time from the ship to and from Xcaret Park of approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes each way. Xcaret is an iconic however very large over 200 acres property with many activities and exhibits for guests to enjoy during their self exploration. Please note, in consideration of transfer time from / to Cozumel and ship time in port, the time spent at Xcaret Park will be limited and may not allow to enjoy all of the available activities. Estimated stay at the park: 4 hrs. Tour price stays unchanged as Xcaret currently only offers one set of rates. There is no differentiation between half and full day rates. The price of the tour includes use of a life vest for swimming in the river; if required, snorkel equipment can be hired at additional expense. Dig into à la carte unlimited food and drinks in one of the two restaurants overlooking the dolphins and the Caribbean Ocean. Your adventure begins with a short taxi ride to Dolphinaris. Before entering the water you will enjoy a Dolphin behavioural presentation where you will be introduced to some of the extraordinary dolphins' behaviour. The first part of the program is conducted on a waist deep water submerged platform. You will then proceed into the deeper water of the natural ocean coves to swim and touch the dolphin in its own environment where then, you will come face to face with a dolphin. You will also have the opportunity to get a kiss, pectoral fin shake and caress the dolphins. Following this, you will be able to use your snorkel mask to see how this beautiful animal swims and glides through the crystal waters of Dolphinaris. Snorkel with tropical fish in the natural aquarium, kayak, or paddleboard in the ocean at no additional cost. To relax after an action-packed dolphin swim, take full advantage of everything Dolphinaris Cozumel has to offer. TULUM MAYAN RUINS - COZ23

Come experience the world famous, magnificent ruins of the walled city of Tulum, the only Mayan city built right on the blue Caribbean Sea! After a ferry ride to Playa Del Carmen, your guide will take you to a motor coach for a scenic and informative drive to Tulum. Once there, your guide will escort you through the ruins giving a complete narration along the way. See restored temples and some of the mysterious hieroglyphic writings still visible today. Visit the temple of the frescos famous for the detailed carved figures and original paints. And, perched on the edge of the Caribbean and rising high above all of the other ruins is "el Castillo" with its breath taking view of the blue water below. A light boxed lunch is included.

Please note: Transfer by ferry to Playa del Carmen lasts approximately 45 minutes and could possibly be rough depending on the sea conditions. Once in mainland, it is an approximately 1 hour transfer by bus to/from Tulum, for a total travel time from the ship to and from Tulum of approximately 1 hour and 45 minutes each way. Traffic conditions may affect the driving time to and from Tulum. Estimated time spent at Tulum: 2 hours. There is a government tax of US \$5 on the use of video cameras in the ruins. No tripods and/or professional video cameras are allowed. Tour is not recommended for guests with mobility problems or wheelchair bound. Guests will meet the guide on arrival in Playa del Carmen. To avoid damaging the fragile ruins, climbing them is prohibited. Guests are recommended to bring reusable water bottles. The use of disposable plastic bottles is prohibited inside the ruins. Guests will walk approximately 1.3 km at the ruins. Walking may take place on uneven terrain. For 8-hour port calls, guests will visit Tulum and then be transferred by bus to Playa del Carmen to board the ferry back to the ship, no free time will be provided. For 9-hour calls, approximately 60 minutes of free time will be provided in Playa del Carmen. For 10-hour calls, approximately 2 hours of free time will be provided in Playa del Carmen. For 11-hour calls, approximately 2 hours and 30 minutes of free time will be provided in Playa del Carmen.

STINGRAY CITY ENCOUNTER - GCA06

Get to know some of the Cayman Islands' famous underwater residents during this excursion to Stingray City. The itinerary lasts around two and a half hours and includes a transfer to Safehaven Marina, a boat ride to the sandbar and approximately 45 minutes to interact with southern stingrays.

Excursion Details

A visit to Stingray City is a popular and much-loved activity on Grand Cayman. This shallow sandbar sheltered by a coral reef in the island's North Sound has long been a meeting place for stingrays and sometimes houses around 50 of them at a time. Join this approximately two-and-a-half-hour-long tour to see some for yourself.

The trip begins with a bus ride of around 20 minutes to Safehaven Marina/Yacht Club Marina. Here, you'll board a snorkel boat and embark on a scenic trip of around 30 minutes to the Stingray City sandbar. Once anchored, climb into the water and spend about 45 minutes feeding and playing with stingrays, some of which have a wingspan of up to six feet. The sandbar is less than three-feet-deep, so you can easily stand up throughout.

This memorable animal encounter is followed by an approximately 30-minute boat ride back to the marina, before a bus transfer, lasting about 25 minutes, returns to the ship.

Then, spend approximately two hours and 45 minutes exploring the park at your leisure. View the tropical birds, sharks, crocodiles and iguanas that live there or perhaps visit the turtle hatchery. Next, travel approximately 30 minutes to visit the island's famous Blowholes, a stretch of natural fountains spraying upwards along the shoreline (depending on weather conditions). These are caused by sea water forcing its way up vertical shafts in the rock, carved out by the surf over thousands of years. Spend another 20 minutes or so admiring the grandiose scene, before boarding the bus for a short ride to the Wreck of Ten Sail. During the approximately 20-minute stop, make sure to check out the memorial for the well-known 1794 shipwreck of the same name and the viewpoint offering views across the reef where it happened.

The final stop is in the East End district, known for its beaches, friendly locals and restaurants. After arriving in the area following a short drive, stop in at one of these eateries for around one hour and sample a traditional Cayman dish, such as fish fry or curry chicken. An approximately 40-minute transfer then returns to the port to conclude the excursion.

Time to leave the ship and instead visit one of Jamaica's premiere attractions, the gorgeous Dunn's River Falls near Ocho Rios, which you'll reach after an approximately 1 hour scenic drive. A plaque provided by the Jamaican Historical Society marks the spot as the site of the battle of Las Chorreras, fought by the English and the Spanish over land rights in 1657 - with the English as the victors. The land was ultimately acquired by the Jamaican government in 1972, since which time it has served locals and visitors alike as a popular recreational area and park. The spring water that feeds the falls is rich in calcium carbonate, which results in deposits of travertine and makes the falls a self-regenerating "living" phenomenon. After arriving at Dunn's River, your guide will lead you up the naturally terraced river bed as part of a human chain. The climb includes a short pause at the so-called "massage parlour", where the cascading water can soothe tired shoulders. As an alternative to the climb, there are safe spots from which to watch the others ascend the falls. You will spend approximately 2 hours at the park before enjoying some Jamaican lunch by the sea. After this, an optional shopping stop (time permitting) will be made before returning back to the ship.



Two of Curaçao's main highlights await the pleasure of your company on a tour that will take you to see both the fascinating underground world of the Hato Caves and, returning to ground level, the wonders of Willemstad's picture-perfect city centre, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Lying just a short drive to the north of Willemstad, the Hato Caves deliver an otherworldly experience of stalagmites, stalactites, limestone formations and, if you're lucky, sightings of long-nosed fruit bats. Returning to the sunshine, you'll then move on to Willemstad to begin your walk through the city centre and its numerous historical buildings. En route to Fort Amsterdam, you'll pass colourful quayside houses before crossing the Queen Emma pontoon bridge to reach the other side of Willemstad city. Should the passage of ships down St. Anna Bay force the bridge to open in the middle, you'll take a ferry instead. The 19th-century Riffort stronghold, now an up-market shopping mall, is your last city highlight on this guided stroll back to your ship. If you prefer, you can equally linger a little longer and then make your own way back to the ship when you're good and ready.

Please note: the order in which the tour runs may vary. As high temperatures are likely to prevail, guests are recommended to wear a hat. The tour involves some walking at the Hato Caves and in the city centre, for which guests should be suitably fit.

BUTTERFLY FARM & NATURAL WONDERS - ARU02

The Seaworld Explorer is a semi-submarine that was developed in Australia for use on the Great Barrier Reef. The vessel does not submerge; you descend into the hull of the vessel and sit five feet below the surface of the water. View sea life in this cruising underwater observatory through large, glass windows. The Seaworld Explorer takes you to the wreck of the "Antilla", a 440-foot German freighter destroyed by an explosion that tore the freighter in two halves during World War II. Delight in your surroundings as your captain manoeuvres the semi-submarine through the heart of the Caribbean's largest shipwreck. Returning to shore, your guide drives you to the California Lighthouse where you can admire the view of the crashing waves of the windward coast and the tranquil waters of the Leeward shore. From here your bus takes you to the Casibari Rock Formations where you may climb the rock gardens to the top of the highest boulder. You will then visit the Natural Bridge, a bridge of rock formed naturally by the wind and the motion of the sea. Finally, you drive past the Gold Mill Ruins at Boca Mahos and back to Oranjestad, the capital of Aruba.

Please note: Guests have to be able to descend with 11 steps into the hull of the Seaworld Explorer. Please wear comfortable shoes. The order of stops may vary. It's recommended that guests bring cash for restrooms, souvenirs, and any food and beverages.

Cut loose from your ship for a few hours and instead enjoy a brunch aboard a catamaran, complete with sunbathing trampolines, sunbathing spots and shaded areas for your cruising pleasure. Your three snorkelling highlights are located to the north, and as you sail, you can sip a mimosa and enjoy some food. Your first stop will be at Catalina Bay, where the white sand beach provides a starting point to go snorkelling in the shallow water and experience its underwater life. Moving on again, your second stop will see you linger a little offshore to view the remains of the Caribbean's largest underwater shipwreck: the German ES Antilla. Having only embarked on her maiden voyage from Hamburg mid-July 1939, the ES Antilla was then scuppered by the Dutch on 10 May 1940, barely 10 months later. Since then, the supine vessel has become home to such marine creatures as coral, sponges, lobsters, hawksbill sea turtles and even moray eels. Last up on the snorkelling itinerary is the shallow site at Malmok Beach, just a little to the south of the shipwreck. After all that activity, you can enjoy some seafood paella and an open bar can while you sail back to your ship. Guests must be at least 3 years old to participate.

Please note: guests are recommended to wear swimwear under comfortable clothing, high-factor sunscreen and to bring a towel, a camera and a hat. The tour may begin or end with a short transfer to/from the marina on an open-air, Caribbean-style bus. Guests must be at least 3 years of age to take part. Children must be accompanied by a paying adult throughout the tour and under their constant supervision at all times. A maximum weight restriction of 113 kg / 250 lb per guest applies.
